Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Bible study will take place next week on Wednesday, January 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm in the church and then the next day, Thursday, January 21<sup>st</sup> at 10:00am, also in the church. As usual, these will be the same class given twice. We will be looking at Genesis 20-22 (which will include the near sacrifice of Isaac, Abraham’s son).

I will be out of town beginning a week from Monday on January 25<sup>th</sup> through Friday January 29<sup>th</sup>. **There will NOT be a morning Mass on January 25<sup>th</sup>, but we WILL have morning Mass Tuesday through Friday.** Fr. Tim Furlow will be here to celebrate those Masses.

We will not be having weeknight Latin Masses for the next two weeks. I have events going on every night next week and then the following week I will be out of town. Our next weeknight Latin Mass will be Candlemas on Tuesday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00pm. You are invited to bring candles from home to have blessed at this Mass. If you are not able to come to the Mass, you can leave candles here ahead of time (with your name on them) and they will be blessed and left in the vestibule for you to pick up the next time you come to Mass. We will also bless some extra candles for people to take home.

Candlemas will be a sung Mass. In fact, I am happy to announce that we will be having more sung Masses here at St. Birgitta’s in the coming months and beyond. Schola Cantus Angelorum will be chanting for now at certain weeknight Masses, but in time once the pandemic passes, we are planning on getting back to our regular schedule of Sunday sung Masses. We are very blessed to have Schola Cantus Angelorum here at St. Birgitta’s! For now, we will only be having members of this schola chanting, but in time the schola will begin having practice and we will invite members of our own choir and any new choir members to join them as well.

As you know, I had asked people to let me know their preference for the Saturday Latin Mass time. It turns out, based on the responses, that over three times as many people prefer the 9:00am Mass time. For this reason, we will be moving our Saturday Latin Mass from 3:00pm to 9:00am beginning on February 6<sup>th</sup>. Also, there will not be a morning Mass on Saturday, February 27<sup>th</sup> because I had already agreed to help another priest with Mass at his church on that day (I will remind you of this again when we get closer to that date). We will continue to have the Saturday Latin Mass at 3:00pm for the next three Saturdays, but **Saturday, January 30<sup>th</sup> will be the last day we have Latin Mass at 3:00pm. Beginning Saturday, February 6<sup>th</sup>, the Latin Mass will be at 9:00am.** Because of this scheduling change, we will also no longer have confessions at 2:15pm on Saturdays. Instead, confessions will take place before the 9:00am Mass. Since I will be coming from my community Holy Hour, I may get here somewhat close to 9:00am, but I know we are already accustomed to having Mass start later on account of confessions.

We still have Epiphany water if anyone would like to take some (or some more) home.

Finally, congratulations to Damien and Theresa Kosel and the whole Kosel family! Matthew Jerome Kosel was born on Wednesday, January 6<sup>th</sup> (the Feast of the Epiphany!) and was baptized on Saturday, January 9<sup>th</sup>. Tim and Katie Willson were the godparents. May God bless the newest member of our parish!
