Blessed Candles – If you would like to have candles blessed at the Candlemas Mass, please bring them next Sunday and leave them in the room to the side of the vestibule (the one with the holy water dispenser). *Please label your candles with your name.* You can pick up your blessed candles at Candlemas or the following Sunday.

Candlemas – There will be a traditional Latin high Mass on Monday, February 2nd at 7:00pm to celebrate Candlemas.

Traditional calendars (which have the image of Christ the King) were purchased by the parish for \$14.95 each, but we suggest a freewill offering of \$10 each. The “Feasts and Saints” modern calendars are free, compliments of Hustad Funeral Home.

New Fire Extinguisher – There is a new “K type” fire extinguisher in the hall kitchen to be used for grease fires. It can be found underneath the red fire extinguisher which is just inside the kitchen doorway.
