Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Happy feast day of The Holy Guardian Angels! It has been a beautiful week liturgically, with the celebration of Michaelmas (the feast of St. Michael, St. Gabriel and St. Raphael in the modern calendar) and the feast of St. Thérèse of Lisieux. This Sunday for the Latin Mass we will be celebrating the external feast of The Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary (instead of the Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost).

For those of you who come to daily English Mass, **there will be no morning Mass on Monday, Tuesday or Friday of this week.** Each year the priests have the Convocation at the coast, and since we cannot gather in person this year, we are having a virtual Convocation on Monday and Tuesday. This starts too early in the morning for us to have Mass here at 9:00am (I will still come later in the day and celebrate Mass privately). On Friday I have an early doctor's appointment so we will not be able to have Mass here in the morning then either (as on Monday and Tuesday, I will celebrate Mass privately later in the day).

Our Saturday English Vigil Mass has now officially moved back to its original time at 5:00pm. We will continue to have confessions before the 3:00pm Latin Mass at 2:15pm and confessions before the 5:00pm Mass as well.

Speaking of confessions, I wanted to mention that when you come to confession in the hall and kneel on the kneeler, there is no need to wipe the kneeler down if the next person coming in lives in your household. This will help us save some wipes.

Catechism signups are still going on, so if anyone in your family is ready for First Holy Communion or Confirmation, make sure to sign up in the vestibule.

Bible study will pick up again this week. We are continuing our study of the Book of Genesis and anyone is free to come. If you would like audio copies of the previous classes emailed to you, let me know. The same Bible study will take place twice: once on Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm and again on Thursday, October 8<sup>th</sup> at 10:00am. Bible study takes place in the church.

I want to thank everyone who has so generously helped the Kosel family following the loss of their home. The Kosels have expressed their deep gratitude for all of the contributions and furniture and other items and they feel so deeply blessed by the kindness of our parishioners. We will be leaving the collection jar out for them this final weekend. It turns out that I was incorrect when I told you how the checks should be labelled. I was informed that checks which mention the family name on them are not tax-deductible (because it is considered a gift to an individual). We will be contacting those who sent checks in this manner. For those who wish, we can cancel and resubmit the check so that it can be considered tax-deductible. If you do not want the deduction, we can leave it as is. Following this weekend any contributions made to the Parish Assistance Fund will go to the general Parish Assistance Fund. However, if you are interested in making a gift to the Kosels after this weekend, please call the parish office. My apologies for the error!
