Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As you know, the 9:30am Easter Latin Mass is currently full. I still have room at the sung 5:30pm Easter Latin Mass, however. If you are interested in attending, just let me know. As for all the other Masses of Holy Week and Easter – these are completely open, and you do not need to sign up to attend.

I emailed out the schedule for Holy Week, but I also posted it on the website for reference.

I am happy to announce that the “Benedictus” sample booklets have arrived! These will be on the table in the vestibule; please feel free to take one home. These booklets are for the Latin Mass what the “Magnificat” booklets are for the modern Mass. In addition to the prayers for each Mass, there are various other prayers and meditations to aid in your devotions and spiritual life. These booklets will be published with regularity later in the year. If you like the booklet, let me know if you would like a subscription. As I mentioned before, a kind and generous parishioner has volunteered to cover the cost of these booklets for anyone who is interested.

There will be catechism after Mass this Sunday.

Next Friday (March 19th) we will have confessions in the office beginning at 6:00pm followed by Stations of the Cross at 6:30pm. At 7:00pm we will have a high Latin Mass in honor of St. Joseph on his feast day.

I am very pleased that another priest will be helping me out one Sunday a month at St. Mary’s in Vernonia. On these days I will not have to leave so quickly after the 9:30am Latin Mass. He will be helping out this Sunday, which means I will be able to spend more time with all of you who are scheduled for the 9:30am Mass this Sunday. Furthermore, I have asked this priest to help out on Palm Sunday as well. This means we will be able to have a high Mass on Palm Sunday at 9:30am! I will still need to leave to go to Vernonia on Palm Sunday after Mass, however, since I will be teaching the adult catechism class there. We will now begin having high Masses one Sunday a month at St. Birgitta’s, and I hope soon to return to the usual practice of having high Masses on two Sundays a month. In the meantime, I will make sure to schedule Groups A and B evenly for high Masses.
