**First Communion** – First communions will take place on Sunday, May 10<sup>th</sup> at the 9:30am Latin Mass. First confessions will take place before Mass. There will be a reception in the hall following Mass.

**Holy Week Planning meeting** – There will be a Holy Week planning meeting on Saturday, March 21<sup>st</sup> at 3:30pm in the hall. Anyone involved in liturgy, music or decorations is invited to attend.
