Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I have been receiving a lot of emails to sign up for an Easter Latin Mass. It looks like at the moment we have 73 signed up for the 9:30am low Mass and 16 signed up for the 5:30pm high Mass. I will let you know when we reach 105 for either Mass, which will mean that that Mass is full. Between the two Masses, anyone who wants to be able to go to an Easter Latin Mass will be able to come.

I also wanted to let you know the schedule for Holy Week. You do not need to sign up for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil, or the 8:00am Easter Mass in English. Palm Sunday Latin Mass will be Group B (poor Group B got snowed out one weekend, so it will be nice for them to be able to come to Palm Sunday). The only Masses listed below that require sign ups are the two Easter Latin Masses.

The schedule for Holy Week is as follows:

Palm Sunday (3/27-28): usual Mass times

Holy Thursday (4/1): 7:00pm Latin Mass

Good Friday (4/2): 3:00pm Latin Liturgy

Holy Saturday (4/3): 8:30pm English Easter Vigil; (no morning Latin Mass)

Easter Sunday (4/4): 8:00am English Mass; 9:30am Latin low Mass; 5:30pm Latin high Mass

I am happy to announce that we will soon start having sung Latin Masses on Sundays about once a month. The first will be Sunday, April 18th. Of course, we will continue to have sung Latin Masses on other days. The next sung Latin Mass will be on Friday, March 19th at 7:00pm (the Feast of St. Joseph).

We will have a low Latin Mass next Friday, March 12th at 7:00pm. This Mass will commemorate Pope St. Gregory the Great. Since we have Stations of the Cross at 6:30pm, confessions will be heard at 6:00pm in the office. This will be the case anytime there is a Latin Mass at 7:00pm on a Friday during Lent (which will be the next three Fridays). After Stations we will more or less immediately begin the Holy Mass.

Finally, I just want to thank everyone again for your contribution to the Archbishop's Catholic Appeal. I will update you on how well we are doing reaching our goal once we start getting updates from the Archdiocese.
