

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

What a great joy to begin to open up our church for Masses once again, even if it is for only 25 people at a time! We've been working hard here at the parish to make sure that we will be ready for Masses this weekend and beyond. For those of you who are on the email list, you have received a message asking for information to get you on the rotation for Masses. Thank you for all who have responded. We are doing our very best to make sure that Mass attendance is assigned fairly. Please be patient with us as it is quite complicated to put the schedule together. If you are interested in coming to Mass here at St. Birgitta Church, please answer the following questions if you have not already done so and we will get you in the rotation:

1. Your name and all the names of the members of your household that are interested in coming to Sunday Mass.
 2. Phone number.
 3. Mass or Masses that you are interested in attending.
 - a. Saturday Vigil (English) – 4:00pm
 - b. Sunday (English) – 8:00am
 - c. Sunday (Traditional Latin) – 9:30am
 - d. Are you interested in coming to daily Mass (English) at 10:00am? Which days (Monday – Friday)?
 - e. Are you interested in coming to a Traditional Latin Mass on Saturday at 3:00pm?
- Would you be interested in coming to a Traditional Latin Mass on a different day of the week at 7:00pm? Which days?

These responses can be emailed to me at jclifton@archdpdx.org. Also, if you are not on the email list and would like to be added, please email me and let me know.

Please remember that according to directives we have received from the archdiocese we must turn away anyone who is not on the attendance list. If you are on the list, you will be notified. Please do not assume that you are on the list, even if you have emailed me your Mass preferences. Also, if you know that you are not going to be able to come to Mass on a certain day (or if you are unsure if you will be available to come), please let me know so that I can assign you to a different Mass. I want to make sure that we can reach the full number of 25 people that can be at each Mass and that no one is needlessly excluded.

Remember that confessions will be offered before the 4:00pm English Vigil Mass on Saturdays and before the 9:30am Traditional Latin Mass on Sundays. And, of course, remember that the resumption of Masses means that our usual Sunday schedule of Adoration, confessions and procession is now canceled, though I am happy to have Adoration and the procession on a different day (and remember that you can still come to the church for Adoration in the chapel... just contact me and we can set up a time).

While I'm overjoyed that we are able to open up for Masses again and that people will once again be able to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, I hope that very soon we are able to return to how it was before and that we will all be able to come to Mass freely.
