Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I cannot begin to tell you how happy I was last weekend to have Mass with all who were able to come! I am still hoping that the day will come soon when all restrictions are lifted and anyone who wants can come to Mass at any time, but at least people have begun to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion again.

We have been hard at work making sure that the Mass attendance list is rotating everyone through fairly. Keep in mind that the Sunday, 9:30am traditional Latin Mass has the longest list so the rotation for that Mass will take longer. By comparison, the English Masses are rotating rather quickly. If you are open to coming to a weekday Mass in English, I will likely be able to get you in whenever you like.

Speaking of our daily English Mass, we are going to begin offering that Mass at **9:00am** rather than 10:00am beginning next Monday, May 18th. I know that our regular, pre-Coronavirus schedule had a Thursday afternoon Mass, but we are going to keep all the Monday through Friday English Masses at 9:00am for now.

This last week, we had a traditional Latin Mass on Wednesday at 7:00pm. This week on Thursday we will have a traditional Latin Mass for the Feast of the Ascension. Thank you to all who indicated that they would like to come. **Attendance for that Mass is now full.** I will continue to offer the traditional Latin Mass during the week in addition to the Saturday and Sunday Masses. If there is a need and people are available to come, I will happily offer two traditional Latin Masses during the week. These Masses will take place at 7:00pm.

Remember that if you are on the list to come to any Mass you will receive an email explicitly stating that you are on the list. Please do not assume that you are on the list because you have requested to be on it. As you have noticed, I am not replying to emails that indicate Mass attendance preferences since I do not want people to be confused about whether they are on the list or not.

If you cannot come to a Mass that you are on the list for, **please let me know as soon as possible** so someone else can have your spot.
