

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In any event it will be an unusual week in this regard, so I thank you in advance for your patience.

Last Saturday we welcomed Doug and Elias Adams into the Church – they received all three Sacraments of Initiation in a special Mass. Congratulations to them and to their families! We will be celebrating the First Communion of Caleb Hendricks this Saturday, so congratulations to him and to his family as well! We will have other First Communions in the coming weeks and months. Once we enter into “phase 2” we will have a special reception for our First Communicants so that they can be recognized.
