

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

By the way, this only relates to Masses that would normally count for Sunday (Saturday 4pm English, Sunday 8am English and Sunday 9:30am Latin). If you receive an invitation for another Mass (a weeknight Latin Mass or the Saturday Latin Mass), these are on a different rotation and you would not need to email me should you be assigned to one of the Sunday Masses as well.

This weekend Aloysius Gonzalez will be receiving his First Holy Communion! Congratulations to him and his family. It looks like we are going to be having one more coming up and then we will be done for the year. We had First Communions in Vernonia last weekend as well. I am looking forward to Phase 2 so we can have a reception for all of our First Communicants.

Next week on Thursday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> the Church celebrates the feast of our patroness, Saint Brigitta (St. Bridget of Sweden). This is her feast day in the modern, Novus Ordo calendar (it is on October 8<sup>th</sup> in the traditional calendar). Since she is the patroness of our parish, we will be transferring her feast day to Sunday. That means the 4pm Saturday English Mass on July 25<sup>th</sup> and the 8:00am Sunday English Mass on July 26<sup>th</sup> will be celebrated as the feast day of our patroness. Let us invoke her intercession for our parish, our country, our world and our Church!
