

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Thank you so much for your prayers while I was away in California for my great-aunt's funeral. I got back on Saturday on time for Mass (even with a delayed flight!) and everything went well for the weekend. Having been gone, I have been a little delayed responding to emails. I am getting close to catching up though! Unfortunately, it looks like my email account was having problems, so you may not have been able to email me for a few days. Those emails would have bounced back to your inbox. I tried to send out a few emails myself, but they kept bouncing back. It seems everything is fixed now, but if you sent me an email asking me something and I didn't get back to you, try sending it again.

Speaking of emails, I just want to remind you to beware of scammers. A parishioner recently received an email claiming to be from me asking for money. As a reminder, I will NEVER email you to ask you to send me money, gift cards or anything like that. If you receive a suspicious email, do not answer it and simply call me instead.

Since our daily Mass crowd has been growing, we have moved daily Mass from the chapel to the church. If you come to the chapel, you will see a sign posted on the door reminding you to come to the church. Being in the church has given people a lot more room to spread out.

I am so happy that people have been asking for Masses to be said. For some time, we were having trouble getting people to send in Mass intentions, but it seems the practice has really caught on. As it is, we have Mass intentions all the way through November! I have ordered the 2021 Mass intention book which will arrive in a couple of weeks. For now, I'll just take intentions for the rest of 2020. **Remember that you do not need to give money if you want a Mass said.** However, you may make a donation if you wish; traditionally people give \$10 per Mass. Just email Fr. Clifton with names or use one of the envelopes in the vestibule which can be dropped in the collection basket. Please make sure to indicate if the person is living or deceased.

I know that some places around the country have been returning to tighter restrictions due to the pandemic. I am really hoping that we are able to move forward to Phase 2 soon. Please remember that we need to wear masks now to come to church. I know that these restrictions are difficult (and it pains me every week to make the Mass schedules and have to leave people out), but let's pray that soon anyone who wants to come will be able to come.
