Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As you know, I will be leaving for vacation on Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup> and will return Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>. That means that I will be here for weekend Masses this weekend and next, then I will be gone for two weekends (Msgr. O'Connor will be saying the weekend Masses then) and then I will return for the weekend Masses after that. This means that I will have to send out Mass attendance lists for more than one weekend. Before I leave, I will send out these multiple weekend attendance lists so please make sure to check the dates in the emails that will say when you are on the list. I will be giving more information about this as we get closer to when I leave.

While I am gone, we will not be having the 9:00am daily Mass. I will celebrate the morning Mass on Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup> at 9:00am, but beginning the next day (Tuesday, September 1<sup>st</sup>) through Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>, we will not have the usual Monday through Friday 9:00am daily Mass. Instead of having another priest come to St. Birgitta's to celebrate those Masses, I am recommending that daily Mass attendees go to Mass at St. Wenceslaus in Scappoose. The daily Mass there is at 9:00am also, so I am hoping that this works with the schedules of those who come to daily Mass. If you want to go to daily Mass at St. Wenceslaus in Scappoose any weekday between September 1<sup>st</sup> and September 18<sup>th</sup>, please email the office at [office@stwenceslaus-scappoose.com](mailto:office@stwenceslaus-scappoose.com) to give them your information. You will have no trouble getting on the list for Mass there since, like here, they have plenty of space at daily Mass.
